People meet their partners online (e.g., FB, Instagram, Tinder)




Developing a conversation is challenging between strangers in online romantic encounters [1, 2]

For a received message (example)


I sometimes cook snacks for my cat.

 B: "How was **food** there?"

A: "I like jazz **music**"
 [sound, **play**, song, band, **piano**]
 B: "Do you play any **instrument**?"
